



## In Tribute To:

Our Associate Dean of Men is a newcomer to the administrative staff, but he is doing tremendous work in helping the men of our campus.




## DEAN HILL



#### **CROSS-COUNTRY**


The 1956 Huron Cross-Country team led by Captain Dave Schultz started the season by placing 3rd in the Michigan A.A.U. and winning the University of Chicago meet.

Despite the absence of several veterans and the loss of meets earlier in the season to Central Michigan and Miami, the Hill and Dalers finished the season victoriously as co-champions of the IIAU Cross-Country Crown. 

The Hurons are heavy favorites to regain the conference title which Central Michigan has held for two consecutive years.






The entrance to Bowen Field house.


#### **BASEBALL**
