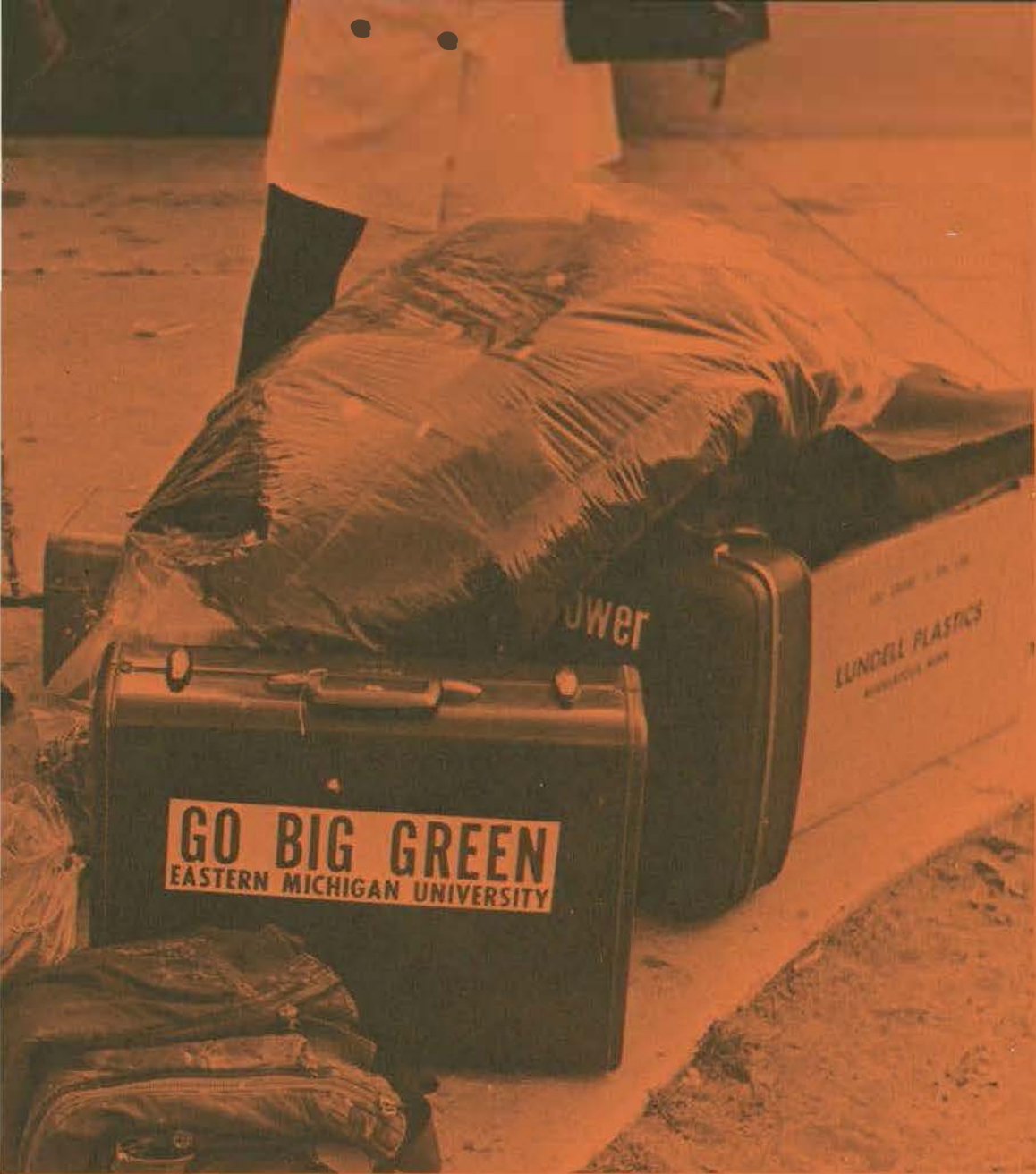


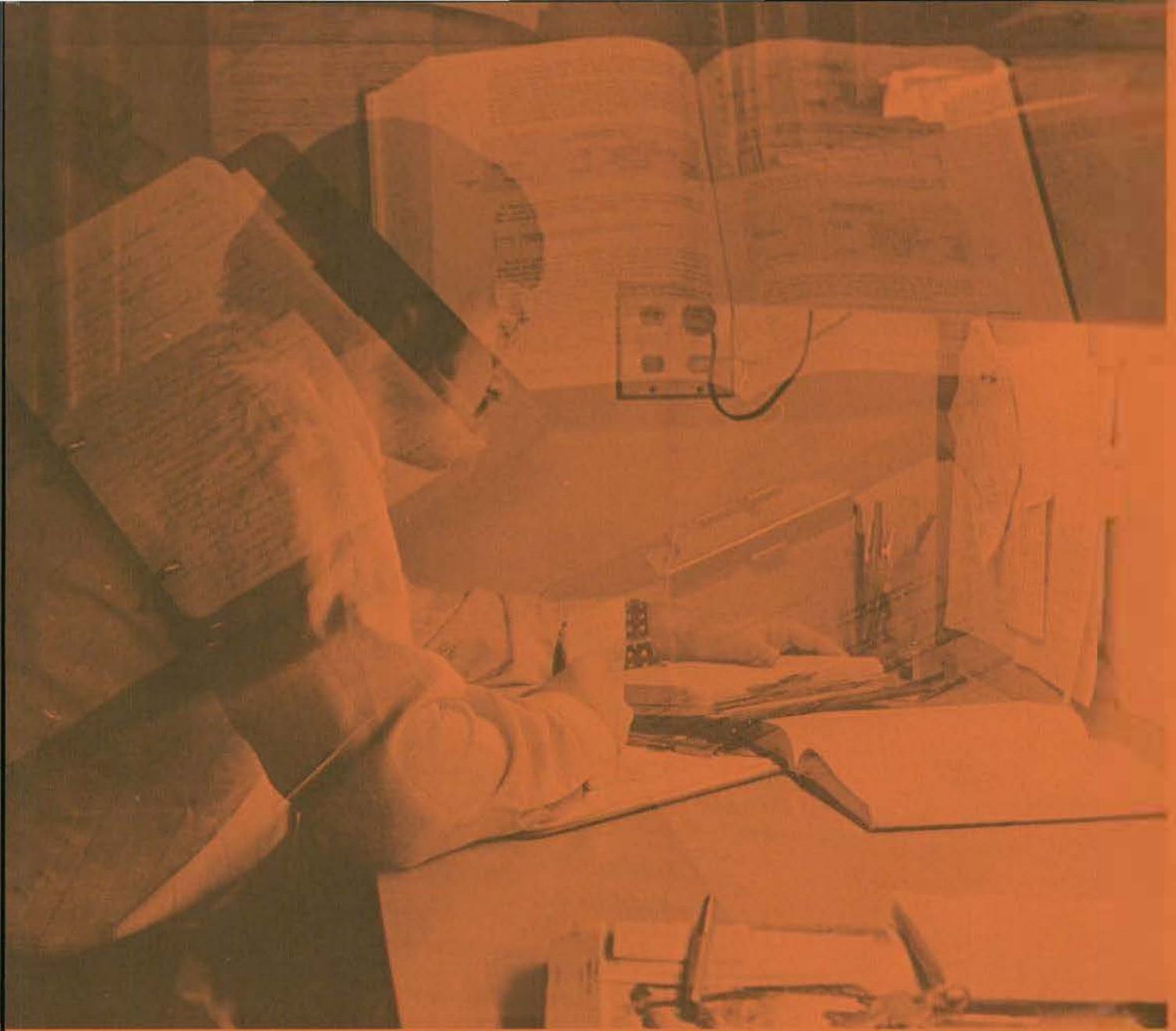





I have walked many miles down

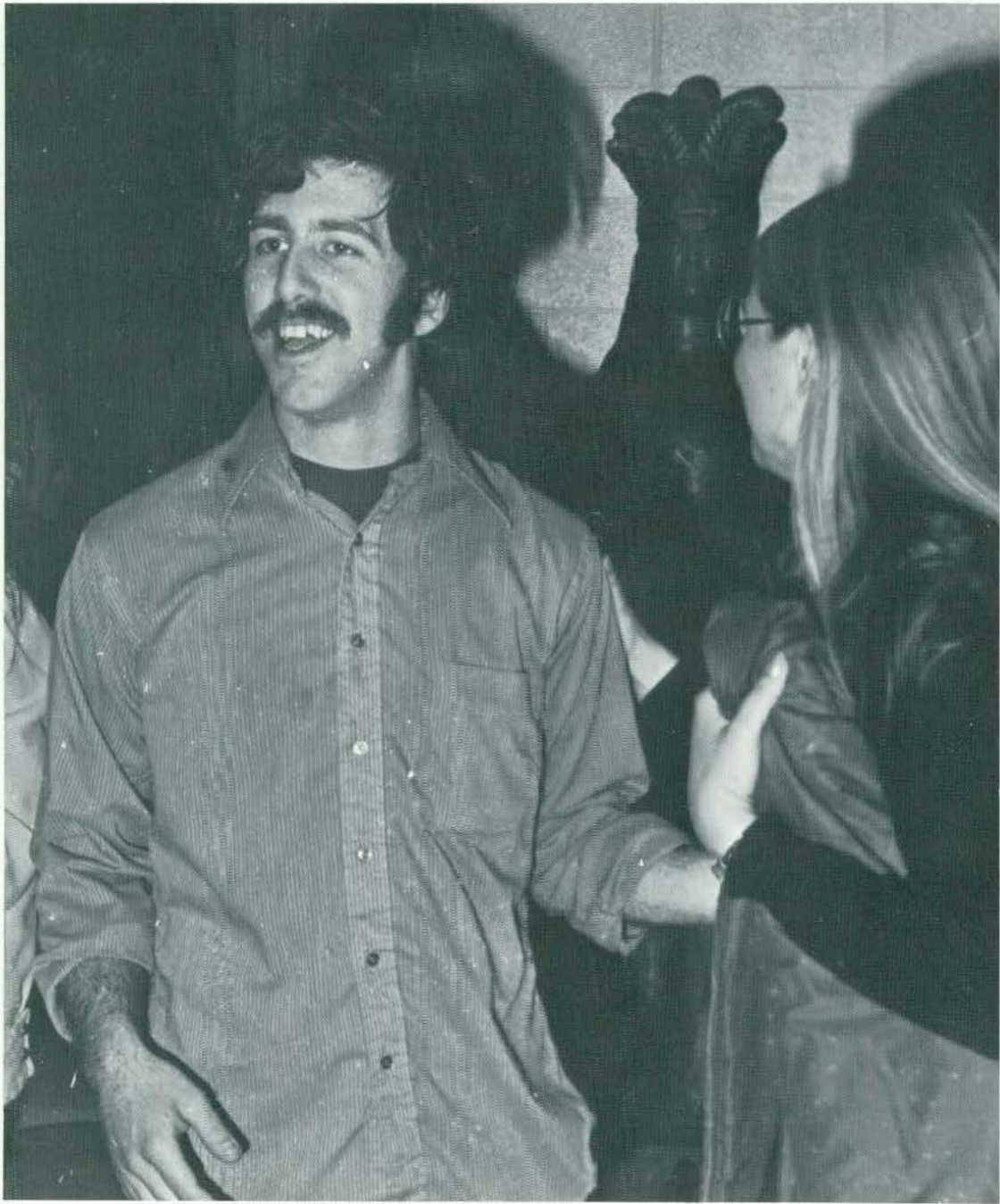


## *simon — student body president*

Barry Simon and Dennis Hertel were elected President and Vice President of the Student Body.

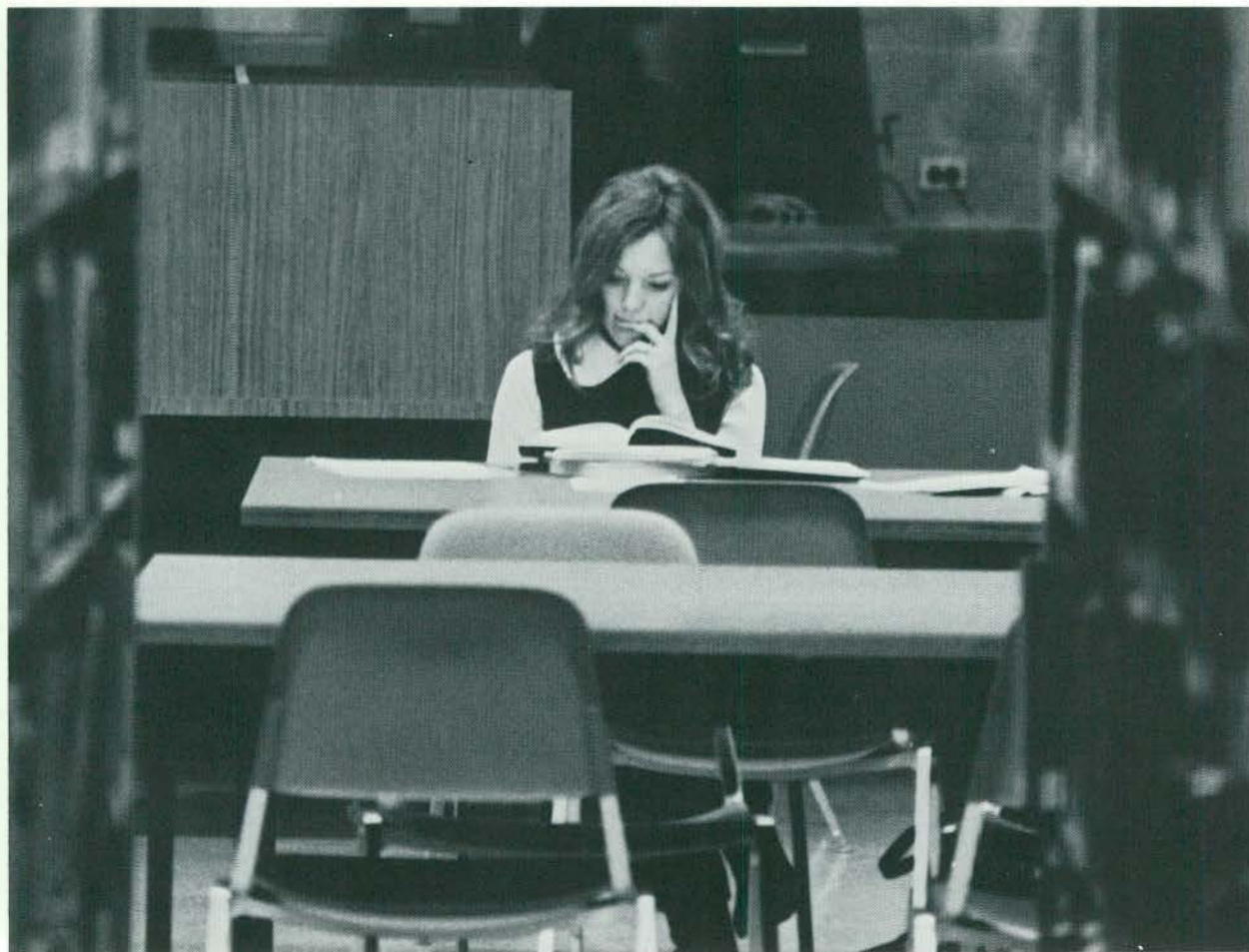
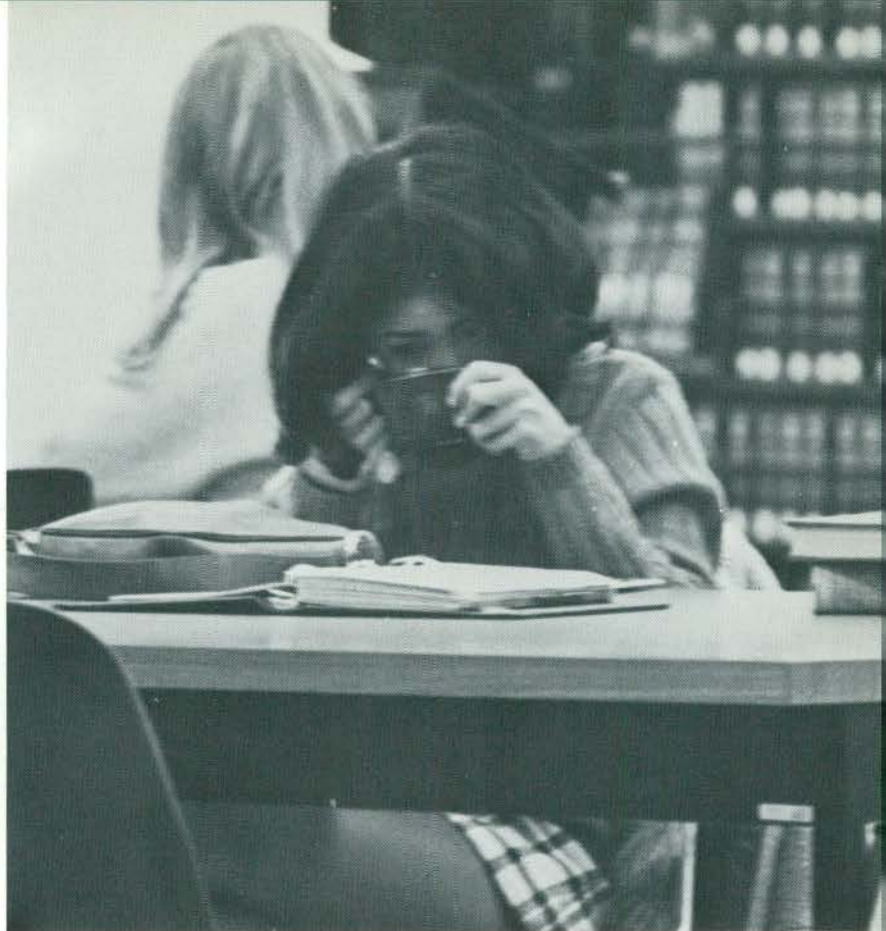


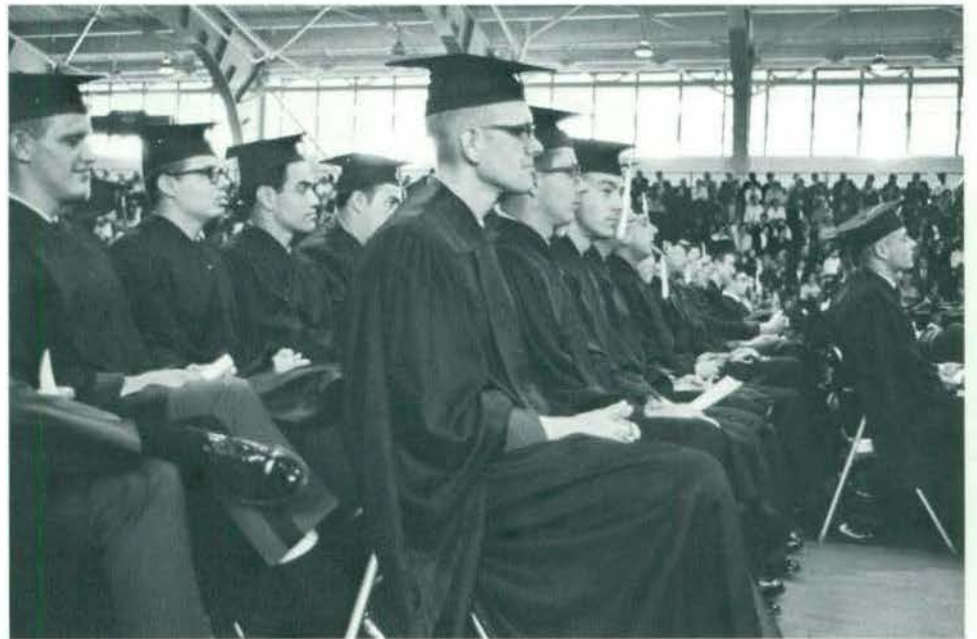
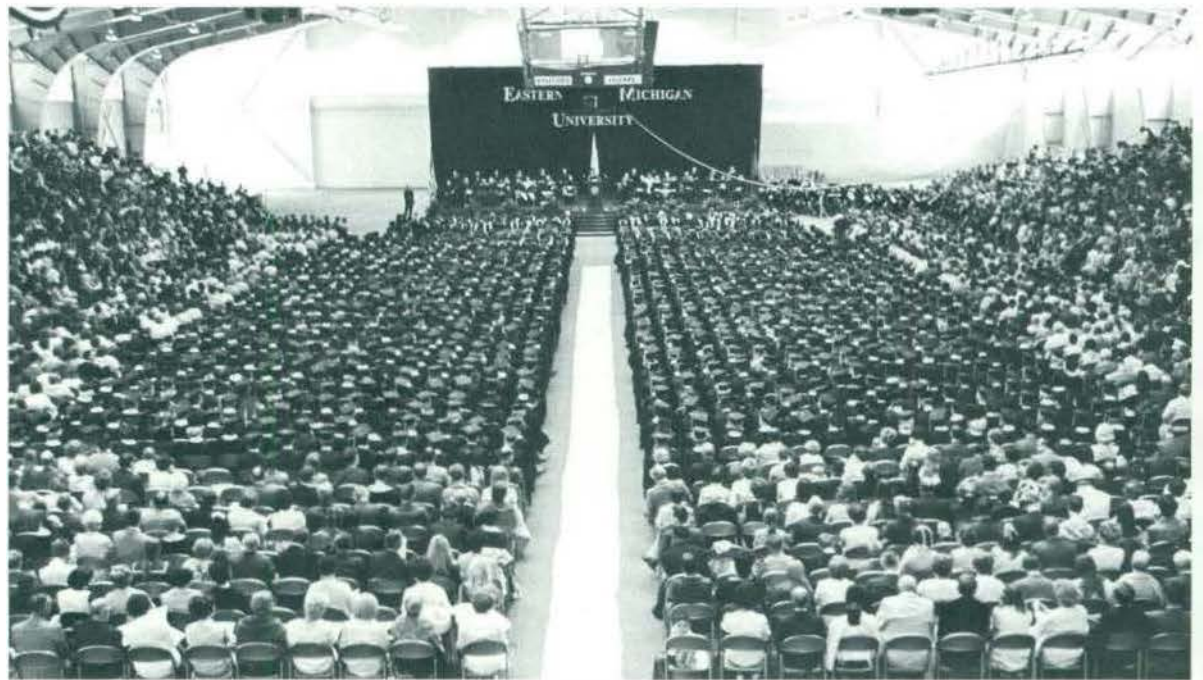

The 1970 Varsity Football Team faced the toughest schedule in the history of EMU Football and finished the season with a 7-2-1 record. The Hurons vaulted into the top ten rankings when they tied the defending national champions of North Dakota State 14-14. They remained there as they rolled passed the Quantico Marines and Waynesburg. Added luster came when they made a miraculous homecoming comeback to defeat Indiana State 25-21. Their downfall came on two tough roadtrips to Kentucky. The Hurons came back from successive losses to Western Kentucky and Eastern Kentucky to win their last four ball games of the season.

Individually, Larry Ratcliff became the school's career rushing leader with 1,660 yards, the first Huron ever to gain more than a 1,000 yards rushing in a single season with 1,011 yards, and the leader in career rushing attempts (312) and season rushing attempts (171). He also tied the record for most points and most touchdowns scored in a single game as he crossed the Ball State goal line four times. Chip Gooden became the number two career leader in pass receiving yardage with 1,183 yards. George Bailey also became a career-leader in extra points attempts (55), extra points converted (43), and punting yardage (7,591). Dave Pureifory led the team for the third straight season in tackles for a loss, with 25, from his down tackle position.







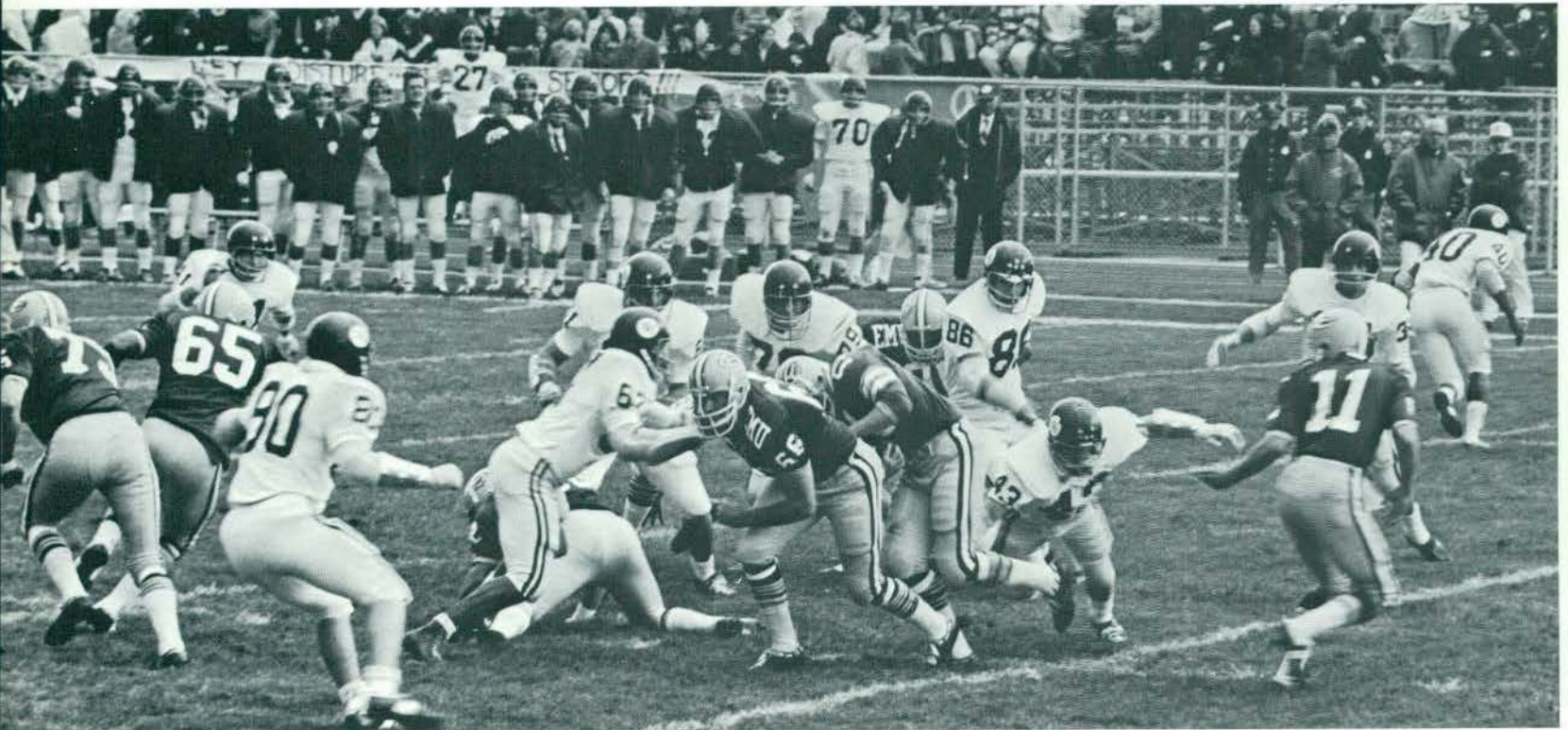

## *huron harriers seize national championships*

Last year Eastern Michigan's Cross Country squad finished with national runner-up honors in both the NAIA and NCAA College Division Championship races. This season they annexed both Cross Country titles to their lists of team accomplishments. Led by captain Wayne Seiler and Dave Ellis, the former Canadian Olympian, the tracksters finished the season with a 4-1 dual meet record. The Hurons went against some of the better Cross Country teams in the Midwest when they took part in the Notre Dame Invitational, in which they placed third. Bowling Green, conceivably the best dual meet team in America, was the only Cross Country squad to enjoy victory over the Hurons. In other championship meets EMU finished sixth in the National Senior AAU and took a first place finish in the Michigan AAU without the support of their top six runners.

## *outdoor team finishes first in naia finals*

Diligent practice, the capable leadership of coaches Robert Parks and Al Pingel, the experience of thirteen returning All-Americans and lettermen, and the help of promising Freshmen have been favorably combined in the 1970 Outdoor Track Team to warrant optimistic plans for future seasons and hopes for many more NAIA Championships.

The Green and White Thinclads of EMU competed in five major relays and one dual meet against Notre Dame in the early part of the season. All eighty members of the squad were consistent in adding points to the all important team score. The rest of the season was devoted to Invitationals and Championship Meets.

Led by Captain Ed Oxley and All-Americans Dave Ellis, Bill Tipton, and Eric Nesbitt the squad placed first in both the NAIA State and National Championships. In the Hammer Throw, John Smiley became a national champ with a throw of 162' 8".

In stiffer NCAA National Championships — College Division, Eastern finished a close fourth, thirteen points behind the winner. With many developing underclassmen, the Green and White Thinclads have added great strength and experience to the thirty events of the outdoor season.







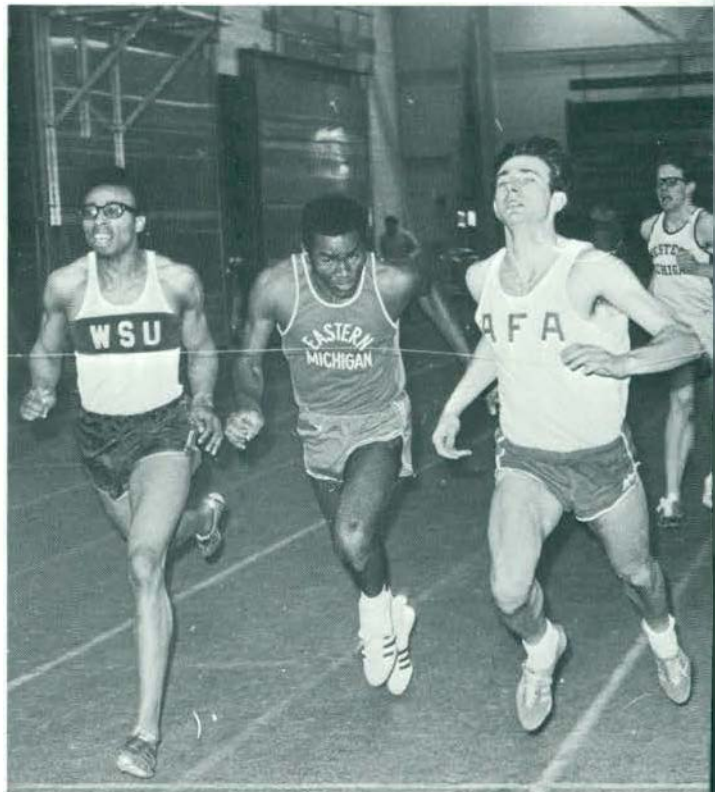

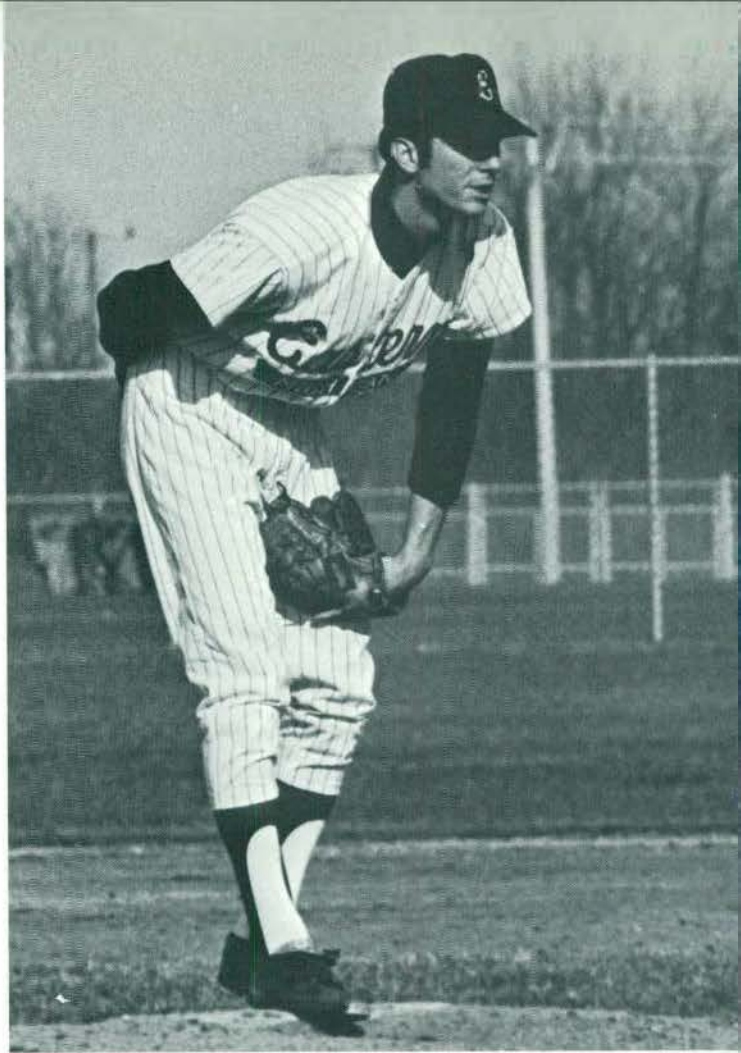

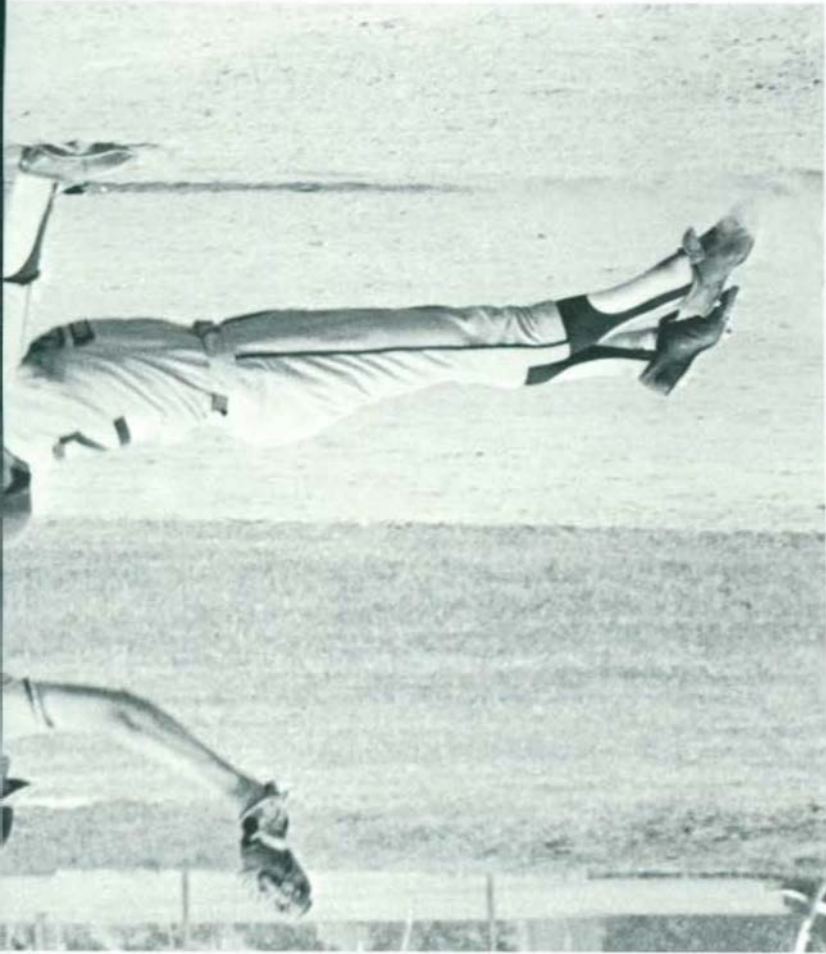


## *hurons seize naia national crown*

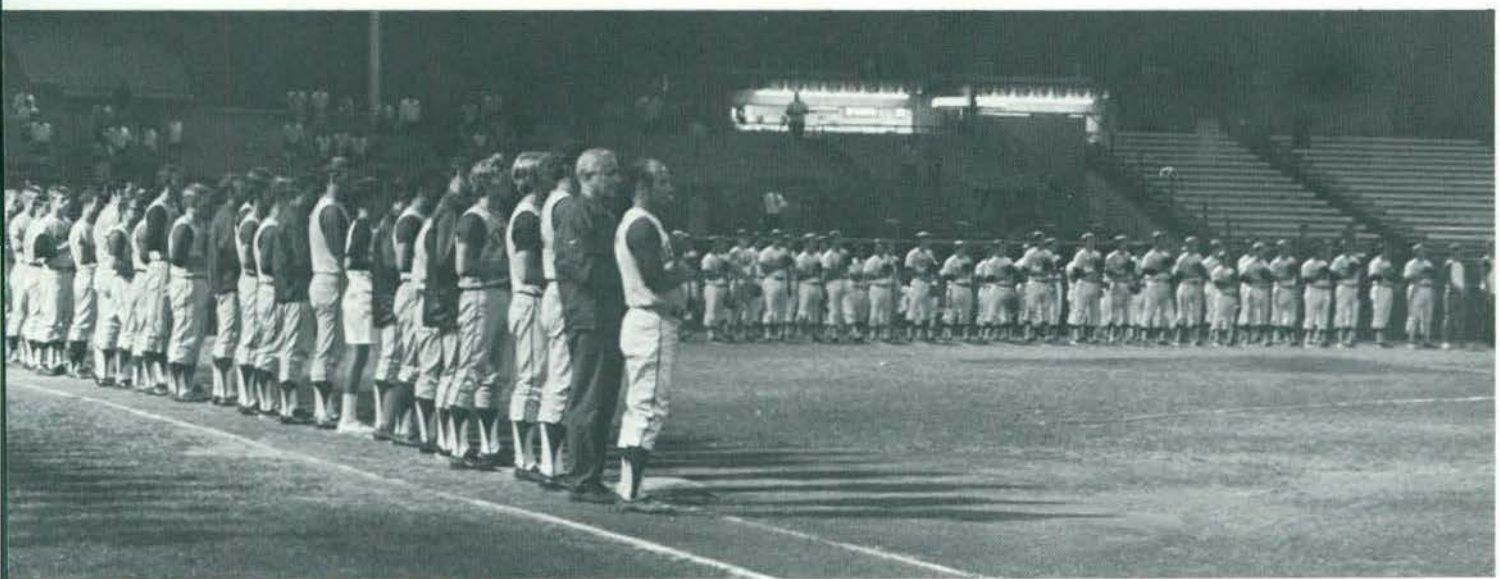

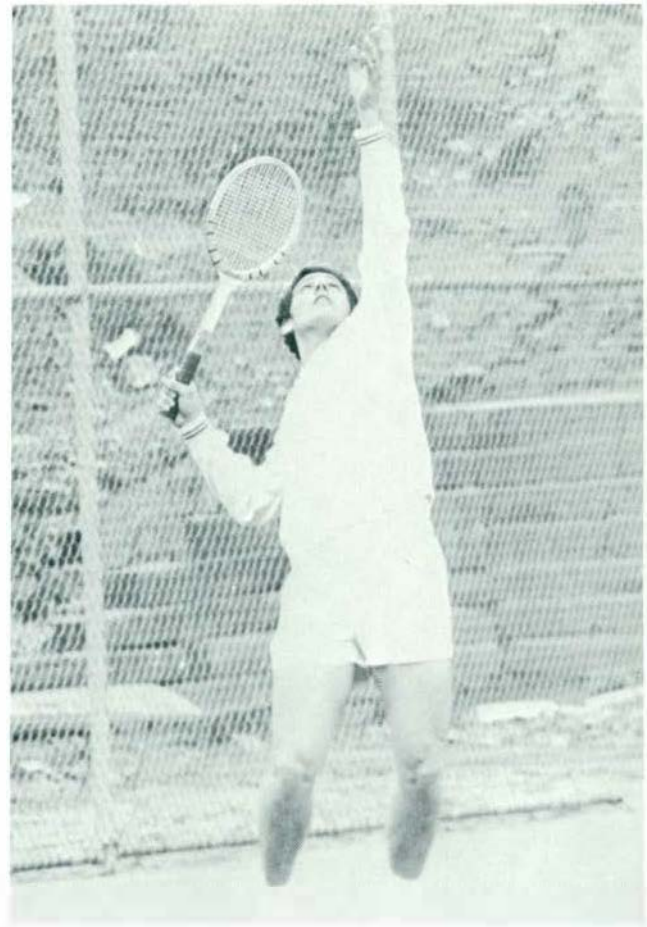


## *meets, practice build netters*

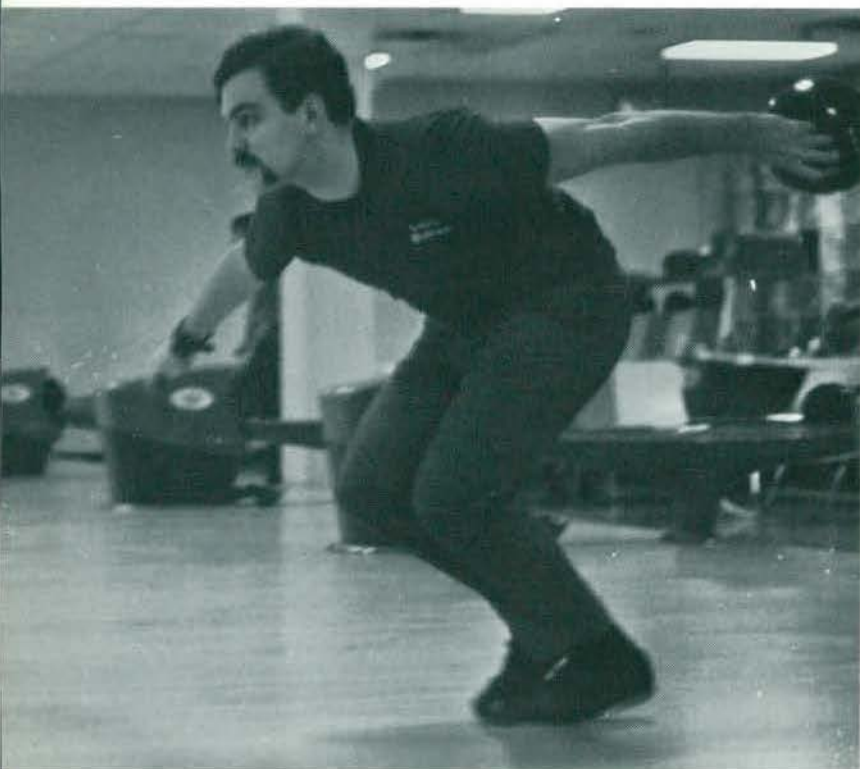


## *under new coach linksmen improve*

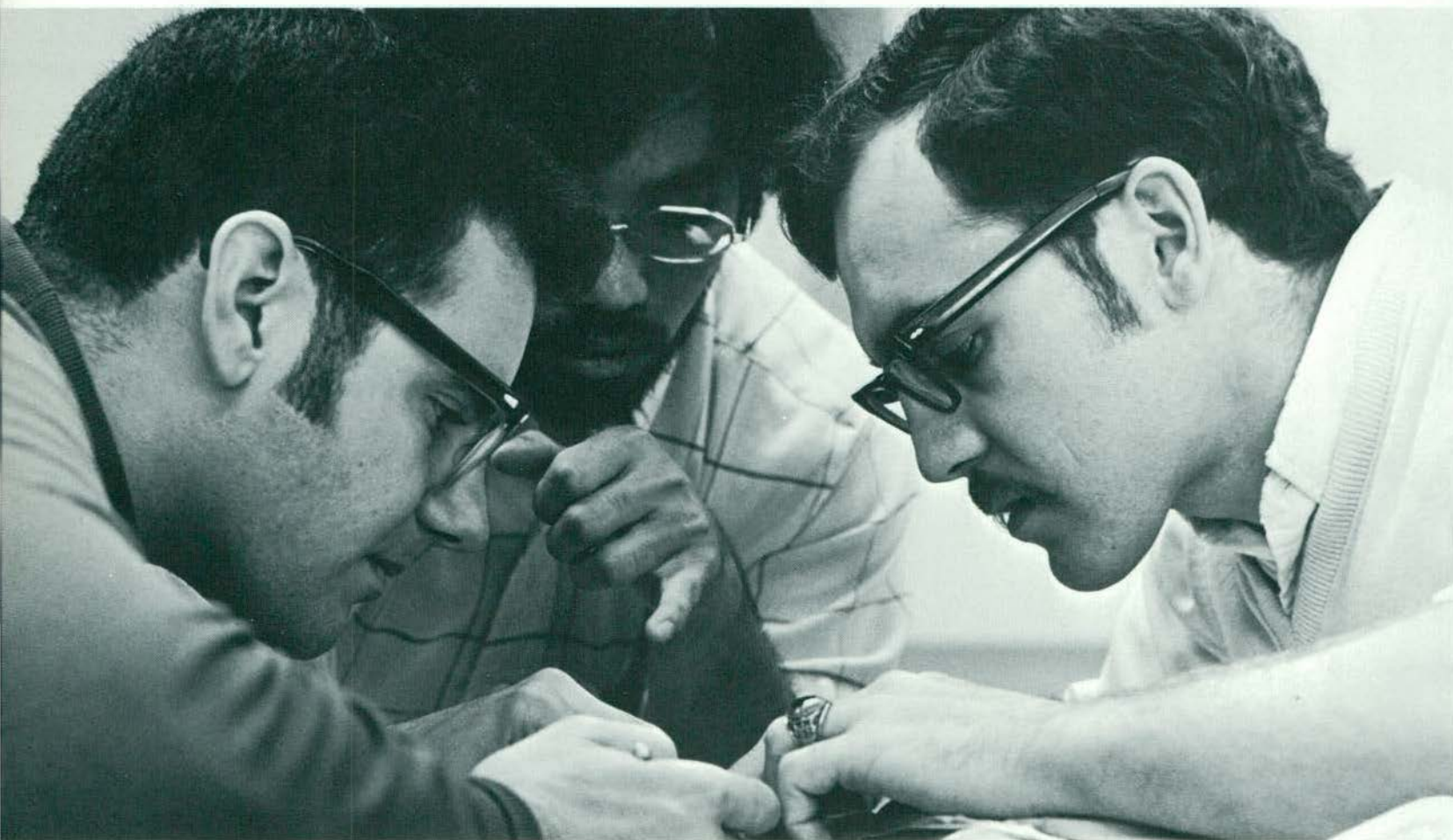








## *exploration and discovery*

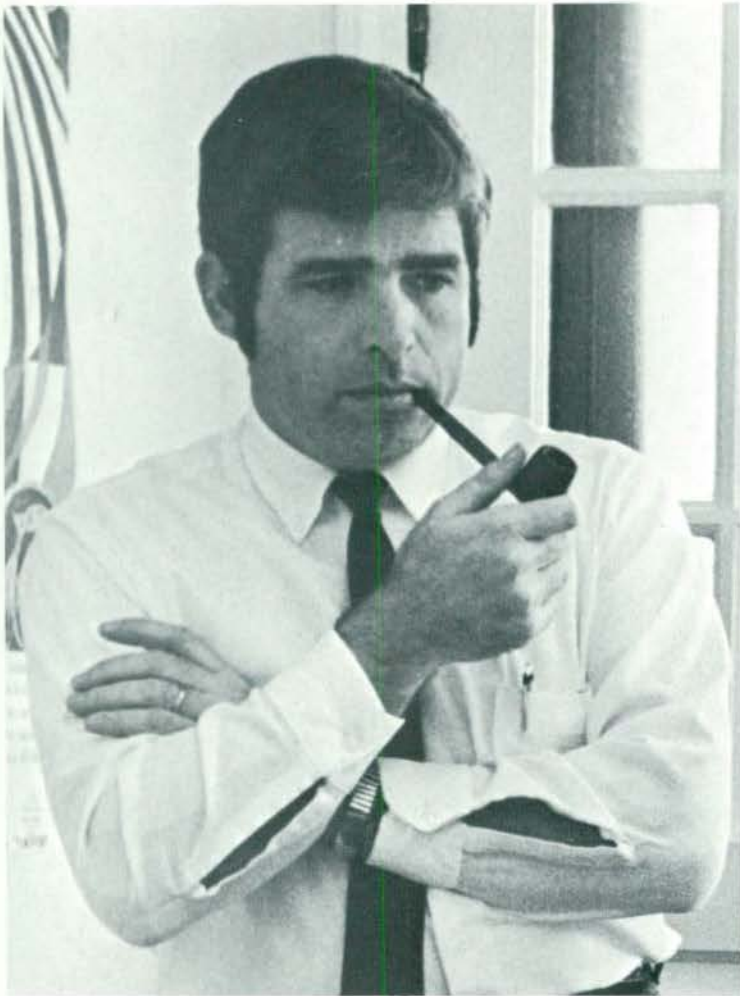
The Health Center has special clinics for medical problems, personal counseling and other services. The staff members possess special abilities and are especially concerned with the health care of University students.

Both the placement and information centers help students to function as completely as possible.







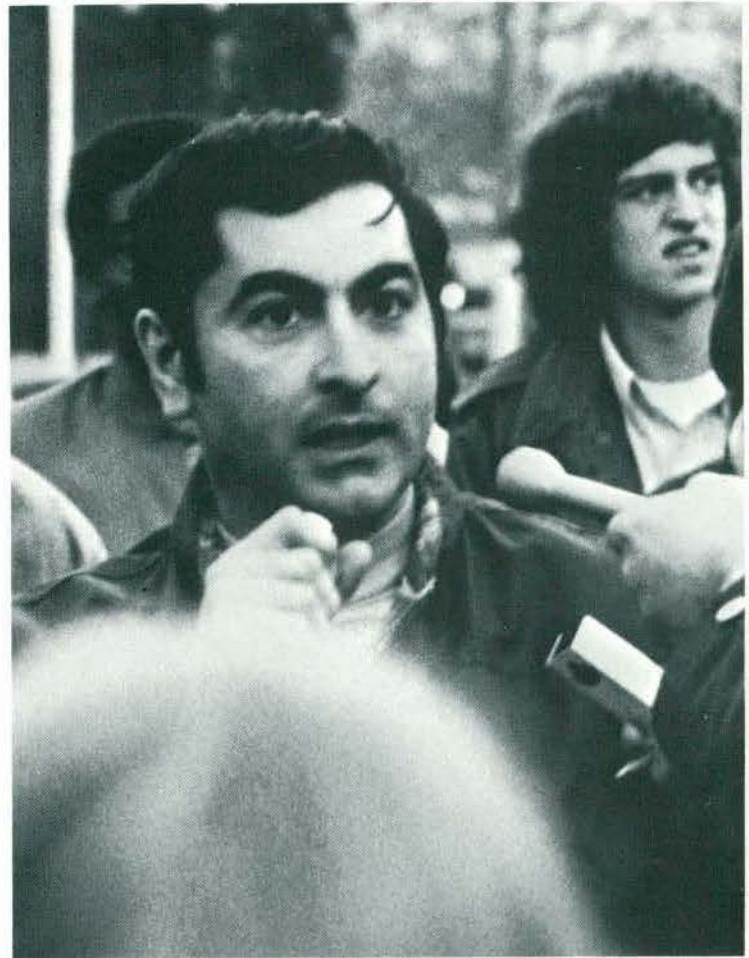

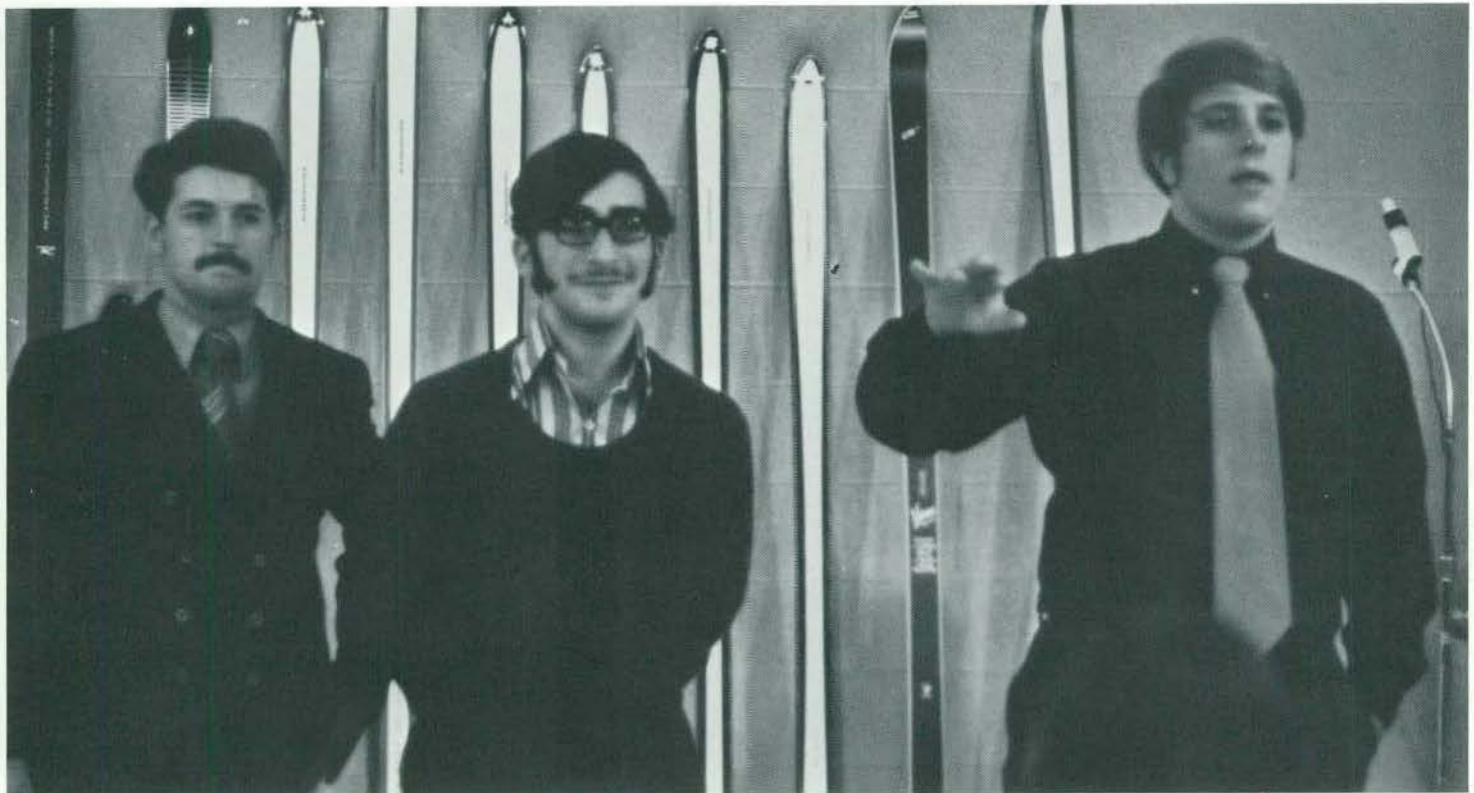


## *skilaufen*

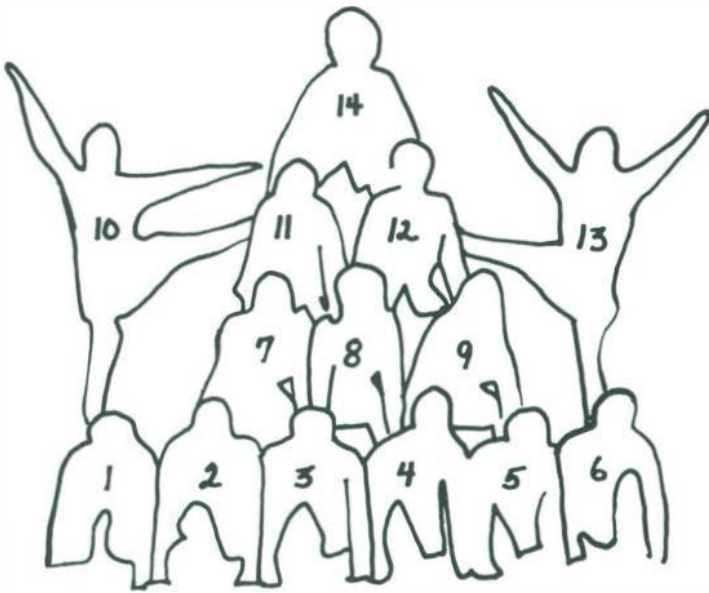


In trending fashion the Huron Cheerleaders have been matching the athletic ascensions stride-for-stride.
