Barry Simon and Dennis Hertel were elected President and Vice President of the Student Body.










The 1970 Varsity Football Team faced the toughest schedule in the history of EMU Football and finished the season with a 7-2-1 record. The Hurons vaulted into the top ten rankings when they tied the defending national champions of North Dakota State 14-14. They remained there as they rolled passed the Quantico Marines and Waynesburg. Added luster came when they made a miraculous homecoming comeback to defeat Indiana State 25-21. Their downfall came on two tough roadtrips to Kentucky. The Hurons came back from successive losses to Western Kentucky and Eastern Kentucky to win their last four ball games of the season.

Individually, Larry Ratcliff became the school's career rushing leader with 1,660 yards, the first Huron ever to gain more than a 1,000 yards rushing in a single season with 1,011 yards, and the leader in career rushing attempts (312) and season rushing attempts (171). He also tied the record for most points and most touchdowns scored in a single game as he crossed the Ball State goal line four times. Chip Gooden became the number two career leader in pass receiving yardage with 1,183 yards. George Bailey also became a career-leader in extra points attempts (55), extra points converted (43), and punting yardage (7,591). Dave Pureifory led the team for the third straight season in tackles for a loss, with 25, from his down tackle position.



huron harriers seize national championships

Last year Eastern Michigan's Cross Country squad finished with national runner-up honors in both the NAIA and NCAA College Division Championship races. This season they annexed both Cross Country titles to their lists of team accomplishments. Led by captain Wayne Seiler and Dave Ellis, the former Canadian Olympian, the tracksters finished the season with a 4-1 dual meet record. The Hurons went against some of the better Cross Country teams in the Midwest when they took part in the Notre Dame Invitational, in which they placed third. Bowling Green, conceivably the best dual meet team in America, was the only Cross Country squad to enjoy victory over the Hurons. In other championship meets EMU finished sixth in the National Senior AAU and took a first place finish in the Michigan AAU without the support of their top six runners.


hurons seize naia national crown


Overall the Tennis team finished the season with a 14-8 record and are preparing for many more winning seasons.











under new coach linksmen improve

From the Carribean, team captain Ian Hall, Wayne Codogan, and Tahyib Khan sparkled a highly regarded offensive attack. European and Middle Eastern contributions appeared in the form of Fredrico Sagarrio and leading scorer Touma Khouri, who had six goals in seven games.

The backfield players were made up of many statewide atheletes playing the game for the first time or who had limited experience previously. Goalie Ted Makuch recorded one shutout and had a 1.20 goals-against average for the season. Chris Edwards, Randy Stark, Wally Foraker, and Rick Riedel brought previous high school and junior college experience in supporting roles for the Hurons. Coming into their own were rookies Dan Venezia, Rick Bolton, Sam Patterson, Denny Wrobel, Dave Stafford, John Cowing, Mike Gibson, John Debien, Art Ellis, and Pat O'Hara.

Future seasons will see a new soccer pitch on the West Campus along with an increased schedule of formidable opponents such as Western, Oakland, U. of D., and schools of the soccer-tough state of Ohio and Canada.
